### **-ELIGIBILITY:**

The show is open to all current members of TAA, and artists are invited to **submit one artwork** of their choice in any media, and there are no restrictions on medium or content. (See Exhibition Requirements below for further information )

**Prospective TAA members or 2013-14 TAA members who have not renewed their 2014-15 Membership Dues need to fill out the attached TAA Membership Form by July 1<sup>st</sup> 2014 to keep their "active member" status of \$30.00 member renewal fee.**

**Note: Annual TAA New Membership and renewal fees are due July 1<sup>st</sup> each year and run through June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. .**

### **-EXHIBITION EQUIREMENTS:**

-Two dimensional works must be framed and ready for hanging with hook eyes and wire. No saw-tooth hangers or wet paint will be accepted, and all submitted work must remain for the duration of the show.

-Three-dimensional works may not weigh more than 50 lbs, and pedestals for three-dimensional work will be provided by the d'Art Center. The d'Art Center reserves the right to exclude works from the exhibition that are too problematic to install.

- **Sizes of submitted work should not exceed a framed width of 40", and height of 40".**

-**Only original works of art completed within the last three years and not previously exhibited at The d'Art Center or a prior TAA exhibition may be entered.**

-**The d'Art Center will charge a 10% commission on all works sold during the duration of the show. Entries not for sale must be marked NFS.**
